Household waste

and small amounts of flammable bulky items

Wednesdays from 06.30 a.m. Bags only **in the official IGKSG (Zürcher Unterländer Kehrichtsäcke) sizes 17, 35, 60 and 110 litres.** Flammable bulky items only with special fee sticker (max. 150 cm/20 kg).



Garden waste and Organic waste

e. g. food rests and waste, flowers, grass, weeds and hedge cuttings, without string and wire

emptying of the garden waste bins from 06.30 a.m. (loose material bundled only with special fee sticker)
March to November: every Wednesday
December to February: every 1st and 3rd Wednesday of the month
Sticker sale: from Tuesday, 9th January, 2024
Christmas tree collection:
Wednesday, 3rd January, 2024
Christmas tree till max. 150 cm and without decorations

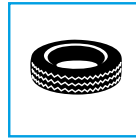

Tin cans and aluminium



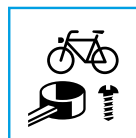
Used oil

mineral oil from vehicles and cooking oils from households (Do not empty all into the power system)



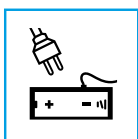
Mineral waste

mixed rubble: bricks, limestone, earth, gravel, clay/cement flowerpots (max. 1/2 m³ per day and household)



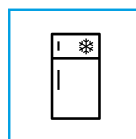
Metal

no gas containers



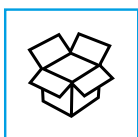
Electronic waste (e.g. computer, printer, phones)

recycle at no charge to retail outlets or at the waste disposal facility



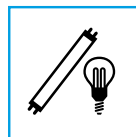
Household appliances (e.g. refrigerators, coffee machine)

recycle at no charge to retail outlets or at the waste disposal facility



Cardboard

plastic-coated carton, e.g. Tetrapack, goes in the household waste



Lamps and light sources (without lightbulbs)

recycle at no charge to retail outlets or at the waste disposal facility



Nespresso capsules



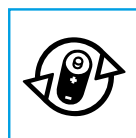
Textiles and shoes

specific container at the lower parking lot of the Riedpark shopping centre (only well preserved and clean textiles)



Polystyrene foam

recycle at no charge to retail outlets or waste disposal facility



Batteries and accumulators

Recycle dry batteries, cameras, toys, etc. at the points of sale or at the waste disposal facility.



Animal carcasses

Batteries and accumulators more than 5 kg (e.g. car/motorbike batteries) to be returned exclusively via the specialist dealer.

Fees and points of sale

Household waste

Official 17, 35, 60 and 110 litre garbage bags from the IGKSG (Zurich Unterland Interest Group for Refuse Bag). No household garbage bags are accepted at the waste disposal facility.

Bulky items

Flammable bulky items up to max. 150 cm/20 kg must be marked with a fee sticker of CHF 3.90.

Organic waste und Garden waste

Bundles of garden/organic waste up to max. 150 cm/20 kg must be marked with a fee sticker of CHF 3.90.

Green waste container

No green waste are accepted at the waste disposal facility.

Waste container

Collecting containers marked in **blue** in the residential area may only be filled with official garbage bags (no loose waste).

Collecting containers marked in **red** do not have to be filled with chargeable garbage bags. Containers filled with loose, uncompressed waste are only cleared with an attached ID chip.

The fees include VAT.

The bases pursuant to Art. 13 of the Waste Ordinance that are decisive for determining and structuring the fees shall be disclosed by the municipal council and published in the bulletin of the municipality of Neerach.
